

Position: Behavioral Health Provider

Position Summary

At the Williamson Health and Wellness Center (WHWC), the Behavioral Health Provider is responsible for serving as an integral part of a clinical team with the core responsibilities of counseling individuals and working with families to assist in overcoming dependencies, adjusting to life, making changes and managing health and social issues. The Behavioral Health Provider will be a dedicated member of the Substance Use Disorder team responsible for providing encouragement to individuals navigating recovery. The Behavioral Health Provider is required to document care plans and notes on patient services and to participate in program evaluation tasks.

General Purpose: This position will be 10% administrative and 90% clinical. Activities will include providing direct clinical services to patients, assisting and supporting the Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) program, and other department related activities as assigned.

Duties and Responsibilities

- Provide direct clinical support and interventions to those with mental health, substance use and co-occurring disorders
- Counsel clients and patients, individually and in group sessions, to assist in overcoming dependencies, adjusting to life, and making changes.
- Complete screenings, assessments, navigate referrals and engage patients in MAT services
- Complete and maintain accurate records and reports
- Collaborate with medical providers to develop treatment goals and monitor patient safety
- Develop client treatment plans based on research, clinical experience, and client histories.
- Review and evaluate progress in relation to measurable goals in treatment and care plans.
- Intervene as advocate for clients or patients to resolve problems in crisis situations.
- Provide clients or family members with information about addiction issues
- Coordinate with other health professionals and social service partners
- Connect patients to resources and the community to address identified health concerns
- Support activities of the behavioral health training program including continuing education opportunities and opportunities to work with students and interns
- Collaborate with staff and others to ensure the efficient and effective delivery of services
- Assist in the evaluation of the scope of behavioral health and substance use services
- Plan and implement follow-up and aftercare for those discharged from treatment programs.
- Follow progress of discharged patients to determine effectiveness of treatments.

Core Requirements

- Licensed in West Virginia or Kentucky as a social worker (LGSW, LICSW) or a professional counselor (LPC, LPCC)
- Demonstrated knowledge or experience with behavioral health and substance use disorder treatment modalities

Desired Qualifications

- Ability to interact positively and build rapport with patients, coworkers and external contacts
- Ability to work independently and organize work to ensure accuracy and efficiency
- Able to exercise effective judgment, sensitivity, creativity to changing needs and situations
- Ability to manage multiple projects to successful completion at a given time
- Ability to protect the confidentiality of patient, employee and business information
