### POSITION SUMMARY:

The Registered Dietitian will be responsible for assisting with community education classes, Diabetes Self-Management Education and for medical nutrition therapy with patients. The Registered Dietitian will provide medical nutrition therapy for individuals with multiple chronic conditions and to those who are enrolled in a Healthy Hearts program for cardiovascular disease prevention. The Registered Dietitian will assess the patient's health needs and diet, counsel the patient on nutrition issues and healthy eating habits, develop meal plans, and evaluate the effects of meal plans or nutritional changes as needed. The Registered Dietitian will provide customized information for patients – for example, teaching a client with high blood pressure how to use less salt when preparing meals. This position will also promote participation in the healthy cooking demonstrations hosted by WHWC twice monthly and coordinate with the cooking consultant on the types of meals and food preparation that would be most helpful for CHW intervention patients. The Registered Dietitian will be part of a chronic care management and prevention team working with physicians, nurses, community health worker and outreach teams.

- Computer skills for Diabetes Self-Management Education data collection, operating the electronic medical records and maintaining HIPPA compliance.

### CORE DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES:

1. Provide comprehensive high quality medical nutrition therapy to patients.
2. For patients enrolled in the cardiovascular health program, complete physician ordered consults and instructions according to standards of care and document in medical record. Connect with the care coordination team regarding any concerns, recommendations, etc.
3. Create care plans with patients and providers
4. Complete and document nutrition assessments on high-risk patients according to standards of care.
5. Effectively communicate with nursing, medical and other clinic and hospital staff to ensure high quality nutritional care. Attends discharge planning and care plan conferences as needed.
6. Provide guidance and supervise daily activities of care coordination support team, i.e. difficult or unusual diet orders, care plans for individuals with co-morbidities, help with cooking classes and community education.
7. Assist with classes regarding area of specialization related to healthy cooking and cardiovascular health
8. Manage outreach, coordination and data collection for Diabetes Self-Management Education at the clinic.
